The following Resolution was presented to the Board:

## AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of OAKFIELD GENSESEE County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town of Oakfield for the repair and improvements of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

- 1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$133,000.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 20.21 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.
- 2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvements of town highways:
  - a. On the road commencing at ALL TOWN OWNED ROADS, a distance of 20.21 miles. There shall be expended not over the sum of \$35,000.00.

Executed in triplicate this 8<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2013.

A <u>motion</u> was made by Councilman Veazey, seconded by Councilman Kabel and carried by unanimous vote to approve the 284 agreement for Expenditure of Highway Moneys.

Resolution for Request for Schools:

Superintendent of Highways, Alan R. Dennis requests Town Board approval to attend Highway Superintendents Schools, Highway Superintendents Fall Conference and any other school, seminar or training sessions pertaining to the position of Town of Oakfield Superintendent of Highways.

A <u>motion</u> was made by Councilman Kabel, seconded by Councilman Veazey and carried by unanimous vote to approve Superintendent of Highways Dennis to attend schooling.

Resolution to Contract for Shared Services:

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Superintendent of Highways, Alan R. Dennis requests the Town Board of the Town of Oakfield to grant the Highway Superintendent of the Town of Oakfield the power to enter into contracts for Shared Services on behalf of the Town of Oakfield as it becomes necessary.

A <u>motion</u> was made by Councilman Martin, seconded by Councilperson Glor and carried by unanimous vote to approve the Superintendent of Highway enter into Shared Service agreements.
