Public Works Supervisor Dennis stated that it is Oakfield's goal for every house to have water and that there is only one house that never will. Oakfield has been looking at Macomber Road for some time and doing this as a joint project makes sense.

Mr. Carpenter also stated that since this is a joint project, the district will be formed after Rural Development has reviewed the application. It could be that numbers may change and if so petitions will be passed again.
