It is almost that time of year again! Summer is coming fast and that means Oakfield's Park Recreation Program is right around the corner. This is a 5 week program running from Monday July 11, 2016 through Friday August 12, 2016. The program is held at the little league park on Drake Street in Oakfield, Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. It is offered to all children aged 6-12.

Registration will be done differently this year compared to years past. This year all registration will be done electronically online at [townfoakfieldny.com](http://townfoakfieldny.com). On the town's website you will be able to register your child for the program along with getting the permission slips for each field trip. Pre-registration is available and is encouraged. If you do not have access to a computer at home, there will be access available at Town Hall or at the library.

Children that are walking or riding their bike to and from park every day must have a signed note from a parent or guardian to do this. They will also need a note to leave the park for lunch. If anyone other than the child's parent will be picking them up, I will need a note giving this person permission to pick up your child.

In the case of bad weather, we will try and not to stay closed the whole day. We will evaluate the weather then delay or cancel accordingly. If we cancel early due to a storm, one of myself or another counselor will contact you to come pick up your child or to grant them permission to walk home.

Lunch will be held every day at the park from 12:00-1:00p.m. Please provide your child with either a packed lunch or money for food. Pizza slices from Santino's can be purchased for your child's lunch as well. If that is the case please send your child with a few extra dollars for lunch that day. The snack stand will be open during the day but they only offer drinks and junk food.

Every Friday during the week we will be walking down to Grandma Rosie's ice cream shop next to Santino's pizza to get ice cream. If your child would like to participate in this, send them in with a few extra dollars for the ice cream.

Twice a week (Tuesday's and Thursday's from 1-3p.m) we will be walking to the Haxton Memorial Library. Not all counselors will be going to the library so children can stay at the park if they choose. They will have the option to check out book during this time, watch a movie, or participate in their summer reading program. A library card is required for checking out books, but they can register for one at the library. They are responsible for returning the books they check out when they are due.

Field Trips are always a major part of the fun at Park Rec. All of the counselors will be attending the trips so the park program will be closed on those days. Permission slips and money are to be turned in one week before the trip and will not be accepted after this date. This summer we will be going to Strong Museum, Minnehans Fun Center, Batavia Movie Theater, Darien Lake State Park (weather permitting), and Sea Breeze.

## **Children's Room Rules**

- **General Rules:**

- Eating or drinking is **not** allowed in the library unless part of a specific event.
- Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- **NO RUNNING!** Walking feet are to be used at all times within the library.
- Children are to use indoor voices within the library.
- Garbage is to be thrown away in receptacles provided.
- Children are to respect the Library Staff on duty.

- **Library Cards:**

- Library cards from any local public library (in the NIOGA system) can be used here.
- If you forget your card, we can look up your name in our computer.
- New cards can be made with verification of a valid ID/license and proof of residence. In the case of a child, the parent/guardian must complete a written application. Applications must be signed & turned in by the parent/guardian to a Haxton Library employee.
- If you have a fine on your card, it is up to the library staff to decide whether or not you may checkout more materials.

- **Computers:**

- In order to use a computer you must sign in at the desk before each use (children also need parent/guardian permission).
- There is a ½ hour limit per day on all Children's Room computers.
- No downloads.

- **Reasons Why Library Privileges May Be Limited or Revoked:**

- Damaging Library property, including books.
- Stealing Library materials.
- Failure to return materials.
- Physically harming or verbally abusing Library staff and/or patrons.
