

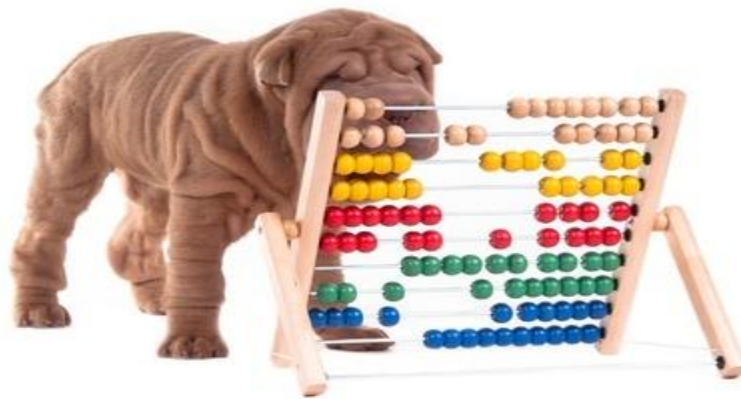

2. Current rabies certificate showing the date of immunization. Certificate cannot expire within 30 days. **PLEASE ENSURE EACH DOG IS CLEARLY MARKED ON DOCUMENTS.**
3. Spay/Neuter certificate if applicable.
4. Current Licensing Fees are Per Dog:
 - \$8.00 if the dog is spayed or neutered
 - \$16.00 if the dog is NOT spayed or neutered
 - \$25.00 Enumeration Fee (If the dog is not registered by 7/31/2017)

DID YOU KNOW?

Article 7 of the **NEW YORK STATE** Agriculture and Market Law **requires** all dogs older than 4 months to be licensed within the Town they reside. Licensing ensures that all dogs have been properly vaccinated against rabies for the protection of both you and your neighbors. If your dog is NOT yet vaccinated there may be a low cost clinic in your area. Please contact 585-948-5835 ext. 101 for more information. Licensing ensures that your dog has the best chance to be returned to you if lost or picked up by animal control. **ANY DOG LIVING WITH YOU FOR MORE THAN 30 DAYS MUST BE LICENSED.**

If you have questions, please call 585-948-5835 ext. 101, Monday-Friday 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

The Enumerator will do random house visits to ensure census accuracy beginning August 1, 2017. If at this time you have not returned your form and are found to be harboring an unlicensed dog(s) **you could be subject to imprisonment and/or court fines, along with a one-time enumeration fee of \$25.00 per dog that will be added to the dog license base fees.**
