

Rules and Conduct of the Park:

Given that safety is the number one concern of myself and the aides at the park, I urge you to review these rules with your children prior to the first day of youth recreation. Any violation of these rules will result in consequences that begin with a warning. Any violation after that will result in your child being asked to leave the park for the day. Further violations will result in permanent separation from the recreation program for the summer. I reserve the right to amend this policy given the specific nature of the action at question.

1. Be kind and respectful!
 - a. This extends to recreation aides and the other children that will attend the program. It also includes any other persons at the public park and those we may encounter on the various trips we will take.
2. Listen to others!
 - a. Recreation aides are at the park for the safety and well being of every child therefore their rules and directions must be followed quickly and politely.
3. Do not swear!
 - a. There is a large age range of children who attend the recreation program. Please do not set a poor example for those who may look up to you.
4. Clean up after yourself!
 - a. Throughout the day children are free to use any of the recreation's games or supplies, but they must be cleaned up and returned to their proper place. This includes throwing away all garbage at lunch and throughout the day.
5. Have fun and try new things!
 - a. This program is designed to provide a safe environment for children to play throughout the summer. They are encouraged to come and to step out of their comfort zone to have fun with the new friends they will meet.
