# Haxton Memorial Library Rules – Park Program Visits

- **General Rules**
  - Children are to respect the Librarians on duty as well as their teen leader.
  - Children are to use respectful language with indoor voices.
  - Garbage is to be thrown away in receptacles provided.
  - Walking is to be used at all times within the library building.
- **Library Cards**
  - If your child has a library card from any local public library, it can be used during his/her visit.
  - We can replace lost cards by looking up your child's name on our computer and no additional paperwork is necessary.
  - New cards can be made IF a parent/guardian has filled out an application. New card holders are put on probation for one month. During that time, the child is only allowed to take out ONE book at a time. Applications must be signed and turned in BY THE PARENT/GUARDIAN to a camp counselor or a Haxton Library Employee. We will not accept applications handed in by the child.
- **Using Cards During the Park Program Visits**
  - *If children have their parents' permission*, they will be allowed to use their cards to check out **ONE** book during a park program visit. Parents must have filled out a permission slip, provided by the camp counselor ahead of time.
  - Children will NOT be allowed computer access during these visits.
  - Children will NOT be able to check out movies during these visits. No Exceptions will be made.
- **A movie will be provided upstairs for viewing.**
- **Summer Reading Program Participation**
  - Your child may enroll and participate in the Summer Reading Program during park visits. Children who join are eligible for all contests and prizes and are invited to join us for the programs' ending celebration. They can participate in the following:
    - Complete a weekly BINGO game card and spin the prize wheel.
    - Guess the number of items in the container.
    - Find the character.
    - Weekly riddle.
    - Weekly prize raffle.
  - If your child does not have a card, they can read books at the library during their visit and count those items towards their reading minutes.
